- 3. Award renewal is based on your academic performance and full-time study in your second, third, and fourth year. You will receive an email notification regarding your renewal eligibility each year.

Payment:

- 1. Payment of the award is conditional on full-time registration in the Rotman Commerce program at the Faculty of Arts and Science.
- 2. Your scholarship payment will be applied towards any outstanding fees on your student account. If the award amount exceeds the fees owing, the remainder of the award will be issued as a refund and directly deposited into your Canadian bank account. Withdrawal or transfer to part-time:
